The obstacle data bases were about six years old so the data bases and the software have been updated in the GPS units in all aircraft.

Director David Hovde presented the hangar report. He is growing grass on the South side of the hangar. The tow bar for the tug for the Archer is almost done. A portable winch is set up. He is working on ideas for gutters for the hangar.

John Biancini thanked the maintenance officers and the Board for their service to the club.
